Theatre is a life changing experience. It can help our children improve reading and language skills, explore complex social and philosophical questions, develop a lifelong appreciation for the arts, and build connections within our community.

We believe our students deserve access to professional theatre right here, in our own backyard, where we all live, work and play! Members of our community agree and have generously donated to the TEN4ONE scholarship program, making approximately 250 free tickets available to each show in our coming season.

We encourage you to evaluate which show(s) best corresponds to genres or themes covered in your curriculum. Bag & Baggage provided a guest lecture in class and the following week students attended Washington County's first professional outdoor theatre production, "Romeo and Juliet." It was an opportunity they couldn't have had without an educator like you. Now, as an added feature, if you schedule to attend either of the first two Sunday matinees, your trip will include a post show talkback session with the cast and crew!
